BOLTER PERFORMS BOLTER, PREMIERES "ARJUNA SPEAKS" WITH US ARMY BAND

BOSTON, MA, USA, March 2, 2009 - Trombonist and prolific composer, Norman Bolter, will perform the solo for the world premiere of his latest work, "Arjuna Speaks," on Saturday, March 21, 2009 accompanied by the United States Army Band "Pershing's Own," in Brucker Hall, Fort Myer, Virigina, during Eastern Trombone Workshop, one of the world's leading trombone music festivals. Bolter's new composition in two movements, scored for solo trombone and wind ensemble, was inspired by the age-old battle of 'good' vs. 'evil' as told in the Hindu account of the Battle of Kurukshetra.

Bolter has received world-wide recognition as a trombonist and composer, serving 32 years with the Boston Symphony and Boston Pops Orchestras and composing works for many prominent artists and ensembles, including the Minnesota Orchestra (Zellmer-Minnesota Orchestra Trombone Competition), Pro Arte Chamber Orchestra and musicians from the New York Philharmonic and Boston Symphony.
